Subs Policy

This policy ensures fair and equal access to organised sport for everyone within our Club, ensures Club sustainability and standards, and most importantly ensures the health and safety of all playing members.

Subs (also known as player membership or playing fees) are a requirement for all players at the Club and payment must be completed otherwise the player will **not** be eligible to play football under any circumstances.

Your Player Membership includes:

- Participation in an organised sporting competition (VAFA).
- Limited Insurance (does not cover ambulance, we highly recommend all players have individual ambulance cover as the Club will call one if deemed necessary).
- Accredited Coaches.
- Accredited Trainers.
- Accredited Umpires.
- Training facilities, equipment (new footballs etc.) & medical supplies (tape etc.).
- Subsidised meals and drinks.
- Access to Alumni resources.

To gain access to all the above player members must make their initial payment prior to Round 1 of the season and must make their full payment prior to Round 3. If a player member does not make the required payment, they will **not** be eligible to play until payments are completed.

There are multiple membership options depending on affiliation fees and student subsidies which you can find on the Club website store. These can also be provided by our *Club Treasurer*.

Refusal to complete your Subs payment in any year will result in owing the Club money and gives the *Club Secretary* the right to deny any clearance requests until the debt is paid in full.
